Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is approximately thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades could vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
